Dr. Sheldon has proved himself to be a qualified, highly effective, caring, and conscientious health care provider. I first came to know his work when he worked at Santa Monica Hospital (1982-1983), when I was the head of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Dr. Sheldon was often asked to treat women who were having unusual difficulties, including helping women in premature labor stop having contractions without medication, and stopping pain when medication did not work.
